

## Clay Powders

Imported from the South of France, clay powders are used as "mud-packs" for the body or face. When applied to the skin, they draw out excess dirt and impurities that can cause blemishes, blackheads or pimples. The end result is clean skin that feels smooth and firming properties aid in the reduction of wrinkles.

Generally you would mix clay at a ratio of 1:1 (half clay and half with the liquid) of your choice or add other nutritious ingredients to enhance the end result.

**#6027 French Green Clay** is generally used for extremely oily skin.

For oily skin try the following additives.

apple cider vinegar  
witch hazel  
orange flower water  
herbal vinegars  
aloe vera gel  
and essential oils of rosemary, eucalyptus, peppermint, petitgrain and lemongrass

**#6031 French Pink Clay** is milder and best used with dry and sensitive skin it is also often used as a colorant in soap.

For dry and sensitive skin try the following additives:

distilled, spring, or mineral water  
milk or cream  
honey  
vegetable glycerin  
floral hydrosols  
cooled herbal teas  
cold pressed oils  
and essential oils of lavender, roman chamomile, jasmine, and patchouli.
