

#5041 Hydrating Eye Gel (unscented)

Due to the fact that this product is unscented you can add your own favourite nourishing and lovely scented essential oils. You can also pump up the formula with a little Vitamin E as an extra dose to combat wrinkles.

If you do add other ingredients to this eye gel – keep in mind the potent effects of your additives. Consider keeping your additives low – at approximately 1% or less in order to avoid irritating the eyes and the delicate skin that surrounds. Only use essential oils that are mild and gentle for this area such as chamomile, lavender, neroli, rose and sandalwood.

This gel has a cooling effect while hydrating and revitalizing. Coneflower (*Echinacea angustifolia*) extract is one of the primary active ingredients. With its ability to heal and soothe as well as reduce inflammation it makes for an excellent product for reducing puffiness as well as calming the delicate skin of the face. Another important ingredient in this product is the active complex of water, glycerin and glycoproteins. This vegetable derived complex has similar action as those found in lectins. Lectins are known for their ability to bind cells and bridge cell surfaces. Methylsilanol mannuronate a derivative of Silica helps to support the collagen and elastin matrix of the skin. As well it plays an important role in the cutaneous level of the dermis as well as improving the venous tonicity. The complex of superb ingredients used in this product result in the improvement and the appearance of the skin and a notable reduction of wrinkles.

Apply a couple of small drops to the your fingertip and pat gently around the eye area. We have found this product also beneficial to the neck and décolleté area. Another area that responds well to this product is the fine tissue around the mouth and lips.
